NOTICE OF RACE

1. Organizing Authority

The **East Asia Classic sailing championship Series 2018** is organized by EAST ASIA CLASSIC CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES ORGANIZING COMMITTEE and BUSAN SAILING FEDERATION as co-organizer in the locality.

2. Rules

- 2.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 2.2 The following rules will also apply or refer:
 - a) ORC Rating Systems Rule.
 - b) ISAF Offshore Special Regulations for Category 3
- 2.3 No national or local authority prescription will apply.
- 2.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

3. Advertising

ISAF Advertising Code will apply. Competitors & Boats advertising will be without restriction. Event Advertising by the Organizing Authority will be:

- bow numbers with advertisement which have to be displayed as forward as possible on both sides of the first 20% of the hull

- advertisement to be displayed on both sides of the foremost 20% of the mainsail boom The Organizing Authority may also require the installation, at no cost to competitors, of on board video cameras, position devices, and guest riders whose on-board position restrictions are defined in the Sailing Instructions.

4. Eligibility

The regatta is open to boats with GPH between 520 and 600 with valid ORC Club certificate.

5. Entries and Entry Fee

5.4 The organizer is not responsible for any costs incurred by the non-acceptance of a boat's registration.

6. Registration

- 6.1 Each Owner or Skipper must personally register in the Race Office located in Busan Marina from 1st May 2018 at 09:00 until 3rd May 2018 18:00.
- 6.2 The following documents shall be presented at registration:
 - a) Valid ORC International certificate issued before 1st May 2018
 - b) Valid third-party insurance with a minimum cover of KRW 100,000,000
 - c) If advertising is displayed, a respective National Authority permission
 - d) Crew list with name, surname, national sailing license and weight for each crew member.
 - e) Contact phone number both on boat and land, including the name of contact person
 - f) Liability acceptance form, duly filled out and signed
- 6.3 No changes shall be made on ORC International or club certificates after 3rd May 2018, unless prescribed by the Measurement Committee and International Jury's approval.
- 6.4 Measurement protests by the boats shall be accepted up to two hours after the posting of the final ratings.

6.5 Crew lists may be amended up to 3rd May 2018 at 19:00 by filling a new form showing the changes. After this time, changes in crew may be made only with the written permission of the International Jury.

- 7.2 Eight to ten races will be scheduled including one offshore race and seven inshore races. Inshore races will be windward/leeward races, except where unusual or extreme local conditions make it impossible to sail a windward / leeward course, then the International Jury may give permission to sail a substitute course.
- 7.3 Inshore races will be of 1– 1.5 hours duration and shall have scoring coefficient of 1.0. Offshore race will be of 35 miles distance with scoring coefficient of 1.2.
- 7.4 The championship is valid if at least 3 inshore races and the offshore race are completed. One discard will be allowed if 5 races are completed, but the offshore race shall not be discarded.

8. Measurement

Each boat shall be available for the measurement inspection from 26th April 2018 at 12:00 until 3rd May 2018 at 17:00. Measurement and rules compliance inspections will be carried out throughout the championship before or after each race with emphasis on boats well placed in the scoring. The inspection will also include freeboards and crew weights whenever possible.

9. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available for each entrant at completion of the registration formalities.

10. Scoring

- 10.1 Windward/leeward race results will be determined by corrected times calculated by Performance Curve Scoring.
- 10.2 Offshore race results will be determined by corrected times calculated by one of the available methods according to the wind conditions.
- 10.3 The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A. Points will be multiplied by the appropriate scoring coefficient.
- 10.4 The series final results for 2018 will be determined by the low average point system. The system is;
 - Calculate the afor each edition the top bottom points of t least, 6 inshore races
 - The series final results are the average of the 2 edition events.
 - The lowest average point will be the 2018 series champion.
 - In the event or less than 6 inshore races in edition or both edition, the average will be calculated by discarding the top point and the bottom 2 points before averaging the points from both editions.

11. International Jury

An International Jury appointed according to the RRS Appendix N will supervise the event; with no right of appeal according to the RRS 70.5.

12. Nautical charts

The following nautical charts of the insert issuing Korea Hydrographic and Oceanographic Administration are utilized as a reference in the Sailing Instructions: Please refer to www.chartkorea.com for availability.

13. Moorings

Free allocated berthing shall be provided from 12:00, 1st May to 12:00, 7th May at Busan Marina.

14. Registration of arrival

The organizer will not operate any services for the entrance to and exit from Korea.

15. Media rights

Competitors, owners and their guests give absolute right and permission to the Organizing Authority for any photography and video footage taken of persons and boats during the event, to be published and/or broadcast in any media, including but not limited to TV advertisements, whatsoever for either editorial or advertising purposes or to be used in press information.

16. Communication

Except when communicating with the Race Committee, a boat while racing, shall not transmit or receive communication of any information not publicly available to all boats participating.

17. Trophies and Prizes

Only a typical trophy for the champion of Spring edition and medals shall be awarded to ranked boats from 1st to 3rd in the fleet.

18. Disclaimer of Liability

All those taking part in the regatta do so at their own risk and responsibility. The Organizer, Busan Sailing Federation, Korean Sailing Federation, ORC and the organization of the East Asia Classic Sailing Championship Series 2018 disclaim any and all responsibility whatsoever for loss, damage injury or inconvenience that might occur to persons and materials, both ashore and at sea as a consequence of participation in the event. Each boat owner or his representative accepts these terms by signing the entry form. The attention of competitors is drawn to ISAF Part 1 Fundamental Rule 4: A boat is solely responsible for deciding whether or not to start or to continue racing.

19. Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party insurance. Regardless, it is the responsibility of the owners to hold adequate insurance cover for Tort Liability and Third Party Insurance (Property and Persons).

In the mean time, owner should submit a copy of his/her ID card or passport with signature. If owner is a company, should provide the registration documents with company stamp.
