NOTICE OF RACE

1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The regatta will be organized by Japan Sailing Federation (JSAF), in conjunction with Kanagawa Sailing Federation.

2. RULES

2.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008(RRS).

(except as any of these are changed by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions)

2.2 For the 49er only rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

2.3 Boats may be required to display advertising stickers supplied by the organizing authority on the boat.

2.4 For 470, Laser, Laser Radial, Snipe, 420, FJ and Seahopper RRS Appendix N will apply.

2.5 The prescriptions of the JSAF will apply.

3. ELIGIBILITY

ISAF Eligibility according to RRS Appendix 2 is required for all Olympic class competitors.

4. ENTRIES

Entries shall be made on the attached entry form by **October 1st, 2005**.

The entry fee is free for the sailors except those who live in Japan.

The following entry fee will be charged for the sailors who live in Japan.

5. REGISTRATION

5.1 Olympic class

Competitors shall register at the Regatta Office of the venue at 08.30-11.00hrs. on Thursday Oct 20, 2005.

Competitors (except overseas competitors) should shown JSAF member's card upon registration.

5.2 Other class

Competitors shall register at the Regatta Office of the venue at 8.00-9.00hrs. on Saturday Oct 22, 2005.

6. MEASUREMENT

Before the registration, Official Measurer shall sign each sail authorized by Class Rules.

At the registration, the Race Committee shall stamp each sail.

Spot measurement checks may be made during the regatta at the Race Committee's discretion.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at the registration.

9. RACING AREA

The races will be held in vicinity of Enoshima Yacht Harbour, Fujisawa, Kanagawa, Japan.

10. COURSES TO BE SAILED

The courses will be the Olympic Trapezoid, the Windward/Leeward or the Triangle.

11. SCORING SYSTEM

The low point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply.

Three races in each event are required to be completed to constitute a series.

12. INTERNATIONAL JURY

The international jury will be composed and their decisions will be final as provided in rule 70.4(b) and (c).

13. PRIZES

The cups will be awarded to the first three boats of Olympic class event.

14. OFFICIAL LANGUAGE

The official language of the regatta will be English in all official communications.

15. LIABILITY AND INSURANCE

The competitors participating in the Olympic Week at their own risk. The Organizers, and/or any party, person involved in this organization will accept no liability whatsoever for any personal or material damage, including but not limited to death, injury, consequential damages, sustained prior to, during or after the regatta. For every participating boat/board valid third-party liability insurance shall be produced at registration with a minimum cover of \$ 5.000.000.-.

CHARTER BOATS

A limited number of charter boats and boards will be available. They will be allocated in order of applications. **The charter fee is free for the sailors except those who live in Japan. Damage deposit is ¥20000- per boat.**

Transportation:

Enoshima yacht Harbour is located south of Tokyo Airport approximately 110km.

1. From Narita Airport to Ofuna Station about 110 minutes by Narita Express.
