## NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The Regatta will be organized by the Japan Sailing Federation (JSAF), in conjunction with Kanagawa Sailing Federation at the venue of the Enoshima Yacht Harbour.

#### 2. RULES

- 2.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* 2005-2008 (RRS). (except as any of these are changed by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions)
- 2.2 RRS Appendix P will apply to all classes.
- 2.3 If there is conflict between languages the English text will apply.
- 2.4 The official language of the regatta will be English for all official communications.

## 3. ELIGIBILITY

ISAF Eligibility according to ISAF Regulation 19 is required for all Olympic class competitors.

## 4. ENTRIES

Entries shall be made on entry form by August 24, 2007.

The entry fee is free for the sailors except those who reside in Japan.

The following entry fee will be charged for the sailors who reside in Japan.

#### 5. REGISTRATION

5.1 All Competitors shall register at the Regatta Office of the venue between 08:00-09.00hrs. on Friday Sep 7, 2007

Competitors (except overseas competitors) should show a JSAF member's card upon registration.

#### **6. MEASUREMENT**

- 6.1 Before the registration, ,each sail authorized by Class Rules shall be signed by the Official Measurer.
- 6.2 At registration, each sail shall be stamped by the Race Committee.
- 6.3 Spot measurement checks may be made during the regatta at the Race Committee's discretion.

## **8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

#### 9. RACING AREA

Races will be held in the vicinity of Enoshima Yacht Harbour, Fujisawa, Kanagawa, Japan.

#### 10. COURSES TO BE SAILED

The courses will be Olympic Trapezoid, Windward / Leeward or Triangular.

## 11. SCORING SYSTEM

- 11.1 The low point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply.
- 11.2 Three races in each event are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- **11.3** When 5 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## 12. INTERNATIONAL JURY

An international jury will be appointed and their decisions will be final as provided in rule 70.4.

## 13. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the first three boats of each class event.

<sup>\*</sup> The schedule of events above may be changed by the Race Committee.

#### 14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

**14.1** Competitors participating in Olympic Week enter entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

#### 15. INSURANCE

- **15.1** Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 30,000,000 yen per event or equivalent.
- **15.2** A certificate of such insurance shall be shown during registration.

#### **16. CHARTER BOATS**

- **16.1** A limited number of charter boats and boards will be available.
- **16.2** They will be allocated in order of applications. The charter fee is free for the sailors except those who live in Japan.
- 16.3 A damage deposit of \15,000- per boat is required

If entrants require to charter a boat/s, they must contact the Japan Sailing Federation.
