## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The Regatta will be organized by the Japan Sailing Federation (JSAF), in conjunction with Kanagawa Sailing Federation at the venue of the Enoshima Yacht Harbour.

### 2. RULES

2.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008(RRS), JSAF Regulations, and the relevant class rules. (except those changed by the Sailing Instructions. If there is a conflict between the rules stated above and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will apply.)

2.2 All classes will apply RRS Appendix P.

### 3. ELIGIBILITY

ISAF Eligibility according to RRS Appendix 2 is required for all Olympic class competitors.

### 4. BOATS

4.1 As a rule, private boats are used. As for Laser radial and 470, charter boats may be arranged for the overseas competitors.

4.2 When a charter boat is preferred, fill in the applicable form in advance and confirm the availability, then apply together with the required fee.

4.3 As for bringing in a private boat, confirmation of the availability to the Shonan Office and the

maintenance shall be done for the competitors' own responsibility.

4.4 The charter fee is as follows:

Laser, Laser radial (hull, foil, spar)	¥10,000	several boats are available
470 (hull foil, spar)	¥15,000	several boats are available

4.5 In case of damage to a boat, the tenant shall pay the additional amount for its repair. The deposit of ¥15,000 must be paid at the delivery of the charter boats.

## 6. REGISTRATION

Registration and Skippers' meeting will be held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the Enoshima Yacht Harbor on 24<sup>th</sup> October, 2008.

Competitors (except overseas competitors) must show their JSAF member's card at the registration.

## 7. MEASUREMENT

7.1 Before the registration, each sail authorized by Class Rules shall be measured by the Official Measurer.

7.2 The measurement certificate for each boat must be shown at the registration.(except charter boats)

7.3 Spot measurement checks may be made during the regatta at the Race Committee's discretion.

## 9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at the registration.

## 10. RACING AREA

The races will be held on Racing Area A off the Enoshima Yacht Harbour, Fujisawa, Kanagawa, Japan.

## 11. RACING COURSE

The courses to be sailed will be stated in the Sailing Instructions.

## 12. SCORING SYSTEM

12.1 The low point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply.

12.2 Three races in each event are required to be completed to constitute a series.

12.3 The scoring system of series score for each class is as follows:

When from 5 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## 13. PRIZES

The medals and the escutcheons will be awarded according to the number of entries for each class.

## 14. OFFICIAL LANGUAGE

The official language of the regatta will be English in all official communications.

## 15. LIABILITY AND INSURANCE

The competitors shall participate in the Olympic Week entirely at their own risk. The organising authority, the race committee, any party, person involved in this organization will accept no liability whatsoever for any personal or material damage, including but not limited to death, injury, consequential damages, sustained prior to, during or after the regatta.

## 16. INSURANCE

- 16.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance per event or equivalent. A certificate of the insurance shall be shown at the registration (a copy is acceptable).
- 16.2 As for the double-handed classes, both skippers and crews shall have the insurance.
