1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The Regatta will be organized by the Japan Sailing Federation (JSAF), in conjunction with Kanagawa Sailing Federation at the venue of the Enoshima Yacht Harbour.

2. RULES

- 2.1The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008(RRS). (except as any of these are changed by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions)
- 2.2 For the 49er classes only rules 44.1and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.
- 2.3 Boats may be required to display advertising stickers supplied by the organizing authority on the boat.
- 2.4 All class will apply RRS Appendix P.

3. ELIGIBILITY

ISAF Eligibility according to RRS Appendix 2 is required for all Olympic class competitors.

4. ENTRIES

Entries shall be made on the attached entry form by September 30, 2006.

The entry fee is free for the sailors except those who live in Japan.

The following entry fee will be charged for the sailors who live in Japan.

Before the registration, each sail authorized by Class Rules shall be signed by the Official Measurer.

At the registration, each sail shall be stamped by the Race Committee.

Spot measurement checks may be made during the regatta at the Race Committee's discretion.

9. RACING AREA

The races will be held in vicinity of Enoshima Yacht Harbour, Fujisawa, Kanagawa, Japan.

10. COURSES TO BE SAILED

The courses will be the Olympic Trapezoid, the Windward / Leeward or the Triangle.

11. SCORING SYSTEM

The low point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply.

Three races in each event are required to be completed to constitute a series.

12. INTERNATIONAL JURY

The international jury will be composed and their decisions will be final as provided in rule 70.4.

13. PRIZES

The cups will be awarded to the first three boats of Olympic class event.

14. OFFICIAL LANGUAGE

The official language of the regatta will be English in all official communications.

15.LIABILITY AND INSURANCE

The competitors participating in the Olympic Week at their own risk. The Organizers, and/or any party, person involved in this organization will accept no liability whatsoever for any personal or material damage, including but not limited to death, injury, consequential damages, sustained prior to, during or after the regatta.

CHARTER BOATS

A limited number of charter boats and boards will be available. They will be allocated in order of applications. The charter fee is free for the sailors except those who live in Japan. Damage deposit is ¥20000- per boat.
